As Mattel was dominating the tracks with Hot Wheels cars and the Sizzlers they took to the skies in 1971. These were Die Cast airplanes with the most sleek and futuristic designs that looked like they were going 100 miles per hour standing still. A total of 6 different designs were offered: Cloud Hopper (only Propeller driven



one), Machine Bird, Regal Eagle, Ski Gull (no landing gear, just skis), Sky Scraper and last but not least the Star Gazer. They all had some kind of operating part. Cloud Hopper: propeller spins, landing gear retracts and cockpit opens. Machine Bird: engine cover opens, landing gear retracts. Regal Eagle: elevators on rear wings move and landing gear retracts. Ski Gull: removable ski landing gear. Sky Scraper: air brake panels open and landing gear retracts. Star Gazer: engine cover opens and landing gear retracts. All of these planes were offered in only five different spectrafame colors: Gold, Green, Magenta, Blue and Red. These all came with a small wire hook (sky hook) that clipped into the top of the plane that would let you "fly" it where there were planes: A Collectors

The year is 1998. Mattel decides to change things up a little with the appearance of the "Red Car" cards. This short run test is underappreciated and not talked about much these days, but it sure changed the look of the peg's in those days. Unfortunately this was also the reason for the demise of the design. Unconfirmed reports are that Mattel management thought that the "Red Car" distracted from the car in the blister.
