#### T-Town Wheeler Picnic—Saturday, September 8th at Haikey Creek Park.

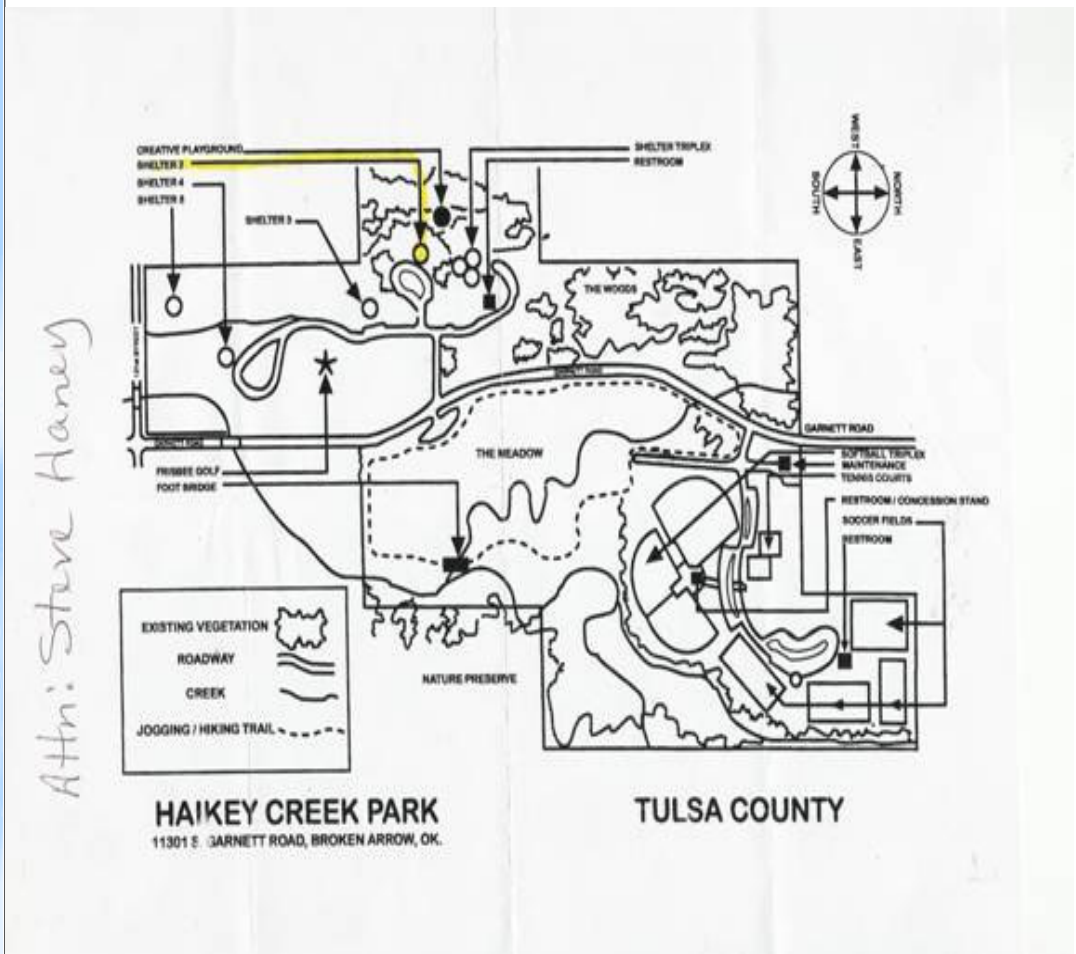
#### Come one, Come all! Need directions?

 To: Haikey Creek Park 11327 S Garnett Rd Broken Arrow, OK 74011 US
1. Start out going WEST on E 93RD ST S toward S MEMORIAL DR. (0.16 miles)
  2. Turn LEFT onto S MEMORIAL DR. (0.24 miles)
  3. Turn LEFT to take the US-169 N/US-64 W ramp. (0.42 miles)
  4. Merge onto US-64 E/CREEK TURNPIKE. (0.54 miles)
  5. Take the exit toward E. 96TH ST. S. (0.69 miles)
  6. Turn LEFT onto E 96TH ST S. (0.43 miles)
  7. Turn RIGHT onto S GARNETT RD. (1.78 miles)
  8. End at Haikey Creek Park 11327 S Garnett Rd Broken Arrow, OK 74011 US
- Total Estimated Time: 8 minutes Total Distance: 4.25 miles

The 9th annual Jay cruise began with a Hot Wheels show in the Jay Museum across the street from the court house in Jay Oklahoma Saturday morning August 11th. The Hot Wheels show had the usual mix of new and older castings with prices ranging from below book to over book. Like almost all Hot Wheels shows there were a few sellers that thought their new finds were worth 2\$ or more since they found it before you did and didn't leave you one in the store. Although the Hot Wheels show was small in comparison to the usual Tulsa area shows the unique twist on the Jay Hot Wheels show was the fact it was being held in the museum. In many cases the collectors tables were separated by museum pieces, display counters or other historic memorabilia that have been in the museum for decades. The best part of the day was later on in the afternoon when hot rods began driving the streets of Jay. Open headers and an occasional burnout kept the crowd interested. There was a good mix of street cars and show cars bikes and trikes rolling into their parking spots on main street and 5th and 6th streets around the court house. The Jay Chamber of Commerce offered hot dogs, hamburgers and drinks on the court house lawn along with a 50's band that played for hours.
