Revealed At Last: The RLC 2007 Rewards Priority Cars!

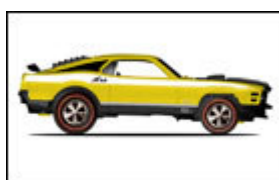
