

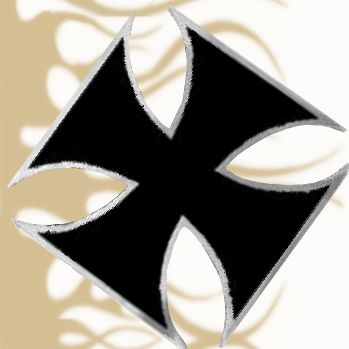

Show Committee      We ALWAYS need volunteers to help run shows.

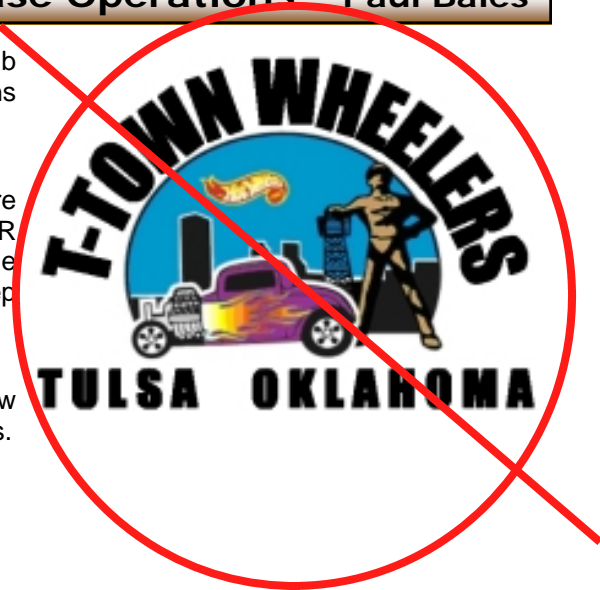
Any questions about the position responsibilities, just ask the current officer. I'm sure they would be happy to fill you in.

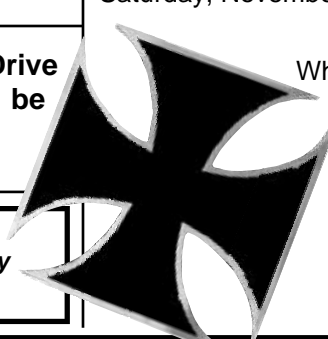
